Air cleaners, humidifiers, answering machines, household batteries, kitchen electronics, vacuums, curling irons hair dryers, calculators, cell phones, copiers, DVD player, fax machines, gaming systems, iPods, MP3 players, microwaves, electric power tools, various media, radios, stereos, CD players, telephone systems, typewriters, VCRs, APC battery back-ups, circuit boards, docking stations, routers, disk drives, inkjet & toner cartridges, keyboards & mice, laptops, MACs, PCs, modems, networking equipment, PDAs, power cords, cables, printers, scanners, servers, server racks, speakers and tape back-ups

There is a recycling fee for: CRT's televisions & monitors \$10 & \$20 depending on size Cash Only

Kent County Hazardous Waste will accept the following:

Automotive fluids, cleaning products, lawn & garden products, workshop/painting supplies. Oil-based paint & thinner, fertilizers, pesticides and herbicides, household cleaners & pool chemicals, fluorescent tubes & CFL bulbs, gasoline, antifreeze, motor oil, mercury thermostat & thermometer, aerosol cans, batteries, propane tanks—small non-refillable. **Do not bring: latex paint, medication, needles, fireworks**
