PUBLIC COMMENT PROTOCOL

Members of the public have an opportunity, under the agenda item Public Comment, to address the Board for no more than three (3) minutes on any item that is not on the agenda. We ask that speakers provide their name.

Members of the public may also address a specific agenda item at the time that item is taken up by the Board for no more than three (3) minutes if recognized by the chair. We ask that speakers provide their name.

Should three or more speakers wish to voice a similar opinion, then an option for a longer presentation may be more appropriate for the group. The group may choose a spokesperson who can address the Board on that specific topic for up to ten (10) minutes.

Civility and mutual respect will prevail at all times.

Public comment is an opportunity for the Board to gather information and hear the concerns of the people, it is not intended for a dialog between the Board and the members of the public.
