At a regular meeting of the Vergennes Township Board, held on July 20, 2020, the following resolution was offered by Ford and seconded by Gillett.

WHEREAS, Vergennes Township does not want to have Township property used for election campaigning;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Vergennes Township Board will remove unattended campaign signs or other materials from township property outside of the 100-foot limit on Election Day, AND a vehicle with campaign materials may park on Vergennes Township property only for as long as it takes for the occupant to vote.

ROLL CALL VOTE – Wittenbach, Mork, Gillett, Rasch and Ford all vote yes, none were opposed.
